





Welcome to the Deer Lodge wine list. You'll find our wines listed by grape variety. The wines within each grape heading are further listed lightest to heaviest in terms of their weight and intensity. To help a little further we have provided descriptions for each wine. The descriptions are intended to give insight into what you're about to get into...a little quip to get you into the bottle, if you will. Sometimes the descriptions are straight forward, suggesting flavors that you may find in the wine, such as cherry, walnut, gunflint or chalk. Sometimes the descriptions are more about a feeling or a mood rather than something specific, such as "...the feeling of a warm house..." or "...an empty riverbed...". It can be hard to find the exact words to describe wine, wine is sometimes more of a feeling than it is a taste or a smell. Sometimes chardonnay is more like sitting on a sunny patch of grass, rather than the scent of fresh apple peel and vanilla.

The flare of Italian bubbles brings hints of lemon pith and juicy Gala apples.

2017 TINHORN CREEK Pinot Gris (Okanagan Valley, Canada) 12gl 60bt

The perfect little pin prick of delicious goodness...perfect for whatever it is you need...

2015 PELLE Sauvignon Blanc Sancerre La Croix Au Garde (Loire Valley, France) 13gl 65bt

A wonderful combination of apricot, shaved merengue and cucumber water.

2015 UPPER BENCH Chardonnay (Okanagan Valley, Canada) 14gl 70bt

Full and supple with summer warm apple and soft toasted vanilla bean..

Perfectly delightful pears dance and swirl around your head...this is wonderfully pleasant..
- 2015 **PELLE Sauvignon Blanc Sancerre La Croix Au Garde (Loire Valley, France)** 40
Memories of mowing the grass yesterday fill your head as you eat celery and squeeze lemons...
- 2015 **DEMOISELLES DE LARRIVET-HAUT BRION Pessac-Léognan (Bordeaux, France)** 59
Yellow plums and sweet spring grass mixed with a decidedly medium body.
- 2011 **MÉO-CAMUZET Chardonnay Haute-Côtes du Nuits Clos St-Philibert (Burgundy, France)** 65
An amazing vineyard just above the Vosne-Romanée Grand Crus. Lemon custard and warm concrete.

Fresh pressed pomegranate with a hint of menthol and black pepper.
- 2011 **CONTI COSTANTI Brunello di Montalcino (Tuscany, Italy)** 75
Costanti's style is lavish, still classic, but delivers a hefty dose of Sangiovese. Dense cherry and rich wood.
- 2014 **PEYRABON Haut-Médoc (Bordeaux, France)** 45
Fresh blackberries with just a slight edge of pine and grilled French loaf.
- 2010 **DEMOISELLES DE LARRIVET-HAUT BRION Pessac-Léognan (Bordeaux, France)** 59
From a most outstanding vintage comes this decidedly delicious red Bordeaux....showing perfectly.
- 2008 **D'ARENBERG Shiraz The Dead Arm (McLaren Vale, Australia)** 80
At a decade old this is just cracking into the treasure of fig, purple licorice and blackberry fruit rollups.
- 2013 **SHAFER Cabernet Sauvignon One Point Five (Napa Valley, United States)** 95
A Napa Valley classic. Concentrated with violets, pain au chocolate.

Footloose and fancy free. Use Mionetto to refresh the palate and revitalize your day, afternoon or night.
- GOSSET Grande Réserve Brut (Champagne, France) ~ 375ml** 75
One of the standout houses for producing wines of great intensity yet remaining quite fresh. Brilliant.

ITALY & SPAIN

- BISOL Prosecco (Veneto, Italy)** 65
Apple and pear and white flowers and everything you like Prosecco for...
- NINO FRANCO Prosecco (Veneto, Italy)** 75
You float carnations down the stream in front of the lodge...they look beautiful.
- SEGURA VIUDAS Cava Riserva (Spain)** 45
One of the world's greatest wine values, cold bergamot, rubber boots and lemon peel.

CANADA

- CAVE SPRING Blanc de Blancs (Niagara Escarpment, Canada)** 75
An elegant and lean Chardonnay offering faint lemon grass and orchard breezes.
- 2016 BELLA Gamay Rose (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 88
This is probably the most exact aroma of rhubarb/strawberry pie you will find anywhere on the planet.

FRANCE

- JOSÉ DHONDT Blanc de Blancs (Champagne, France)** 135
The Chardonnay here is perfectly poised to showcase acacia flowers and ground white stone.
- VOUETTE & SORBÉE (Champagne, France)** 120
Quite an interesting style. Marvelously high tones of cured lemon and blanched almonds.
- PIERRE PÉTERS Cuvée de Réserve (Champagne, France) ~ Served From Magnum ~** 275
Showing pronounced acidity and highly defined minerality...a perfect bottle of sparkling chardonnay.
- JACQUESSON Cuvée 734 DT (Champagne, France)** 250
This wine is based on the exceptional 2006 vintage and saw eight years aging before release!! Superb.

WHITE

PINOTS

- 2016 **SANDHILL Pinot Gris (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 55
Light notes of freshly ground pepper, bay leaf, Anjou pear and fresh Okanagan apple.
- 2015 **JERMANN Pinot Grigio (Venezia Guilia, Italy)** 69
Richer and rounder than you might expect...Jermann heaves a good deal of concentration into this.
- 2014 **SKYLARK Pinot Blanc (Mendocino County, United States)** 55
A moist apple and pear flan that you have for breakfast...you drink warm chamomile tea.

SAUVIGNON BLANC & CHENIN BLANC

- 2015 **QUINTAY Sauvignon Blanc Clava (Casablanca, Chile)** 50
You drink iced ginger tea and then try to make that whistling noise through a blade of grass...
- 2016 **DOG POINT Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough, New Zealand)** 65
Very muscular with papaya, gooseberry and white flowers.
- 2016 **KITTEN SWISH Chenin Blanc (Dry Creek Valley, United States)** 75
A key limes rubbed over river bed stones and soaked in chamomile tea.

RIESLING

- 2015 **SYNCHROMESH Thorny Vines Vineyard (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 75
Aromatic and quite fruity on the mid palate...makes for a perfectly refreshing sip.
- 2016 **TANTALUS (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 68
Tantalus makes a most powerful dry Riesling with searing acids, sage and ginger.
- 2013 **LITTLE FARM Mulberry Tree Vineyard (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 85
Tight and would up like an elastic band around your finger...you love the squeeze.
- 2013 **PEWSEY VALE Riesling (Eden Valley, Australia)** 55
One of the world's classic dry Rieslings, Lime and white flowers.
- 2009 **TRIMBACH Cuvée Frédéric Emile (Alsace, France)** 125
Lavish in the most understated way, so well designed and so well executed it's hard not to gulp. Yes!
- 2014 **MAIN DIVIDE (Waipara, New Zealand)** 55
Flat out delicious. A hint of sweetness here...but that's ok...you take honey in your tea...
- 2010 **FELTON ROAD (Central Otago, New Zealand)** 68
A little sweetness to balance the bright acids, complete harmony, and rare to find with a touch of age.
- 2009 **TONI JOST Bacharach Feinherb (Mittelrhein, Germany)** 65
From the town of Bacharach. Feinherb is to Riesling as relish is to hotdogs, fattens it, but keeps it tart.
- 2011 **SELBACH-OSTER Zeltinger Schlossberg Spätlese (Mosel-Saar-Ruwer, Germany)** 85
Spritely for such a richly textured wine. Saffron dots the palate in the most delicate way.

SEMILLON

- 2004 **TYRELL'S Vat 1 (Hunter Valley, Australia)** 125
One of the world's greatest dry Semillons. This current release is just cracking into glory.
- 2010 **BOEKENHOUTSKLOOF (Franschoek, South Africa)** 85
Honeycomb and chamomile tea steeped to the point of becoming just slightly bitter...wonderful.

CHARDONNAY

- 2016 **MEYER FAMILY (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 75
A top producer of Chardonnay in Canada. A hint of pinecone, fresh moss and lemon peel.
- 2014 **CHRISTOPHE Chablis Mont Milieu (Burgundy, France)** 95
The moment when the morning sun hits the dew on the concrete steps on your front yard walkway.
- 2014 **JEAN FOURNIER Marsannay Cuvee Saint-Urbain (Burgundy, France)** 85
Sultry on the tongue with warm hay and fridge cold cauliflower...perfect for right now.
- 2016 **CATENA (Mendoza, Argentina)** 58
Roasted cashew ground and rolled over freshly peeled Gala apples.
- 2010 **MICHEL LAFARGE Meursault (Burgundy, France)** 135
Like waking up from a dream, sharp images blur into bliss. Not sure what happened, but it was nice.
- 2010 **ETIENNE SAUZET Puligny-Montrachet (Burgundy, France)** 165
A monster in terms of balancing power and agility. River washed minerals with camphor and fava bean.
- 2011 **ANNE - CLAUDE LEFLAIVE Puligny-Montrachet Clavoillon Premier Cru (Burgundy, France)** 195
The doyen of white burgundy. A mind shattering journey into the depths of what great wine is all about.
- 2013 **FOXGLOVE (Central Coast, United States)** 68
A classic Californian Chardonnay. Toasted coconut shavings and apple slices.
- 2012 **RIDGE Estate (Santa Cruz Mountains, United States)** 145
Elegant and balanced. Soft wood notes cradle the rich orchard fruit.

GEWURZTRAMINER

- 2011 **COLTERENZIO Schreckbichl (Alto Adige, Italy)** 59
Such precision here. Lavendar, lime leaf, hickory. Schreckbichl means "scary hill"...so ya know....
- 2011 **PAUL ZINCK (Alsace, France)** 48
A delight of rose petal, camphor, and a faint whiff of rosemary.

ROSÉ

- 2016 **JOIEFARM (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 55
A fruit rollup made with under ripe strawberries, sun ripened cranberries and a hint of lipstick.
- 2016 **MAC FORBES Woori Yallock (Yarra Valley, Australia)** 75
All from Pinot Noir. This is lifted and very fresh with toned cranberry and fridge cold strawberry.

PINOT NOIR

- 2012 **TOLPUDDLE (Coal River Valley, Australia)** 125
From some of the coolest parts of Australia comes this lithe and herbal induced red...perfect right now.
- 2014 **JOHANNESHOF REINISH (Thermenregion, Austria)** 68
We don't tend, at least in Canada, to think of Austria for producing amazing Pinot Noir...but we should.
- 2014 **MISSION HILL Five Vineyards (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 55
Soft and easy...playful even.
- 2006 **LIGNIER-MICHELOT Clos de la Roche Grand Cru (Burgundy, France)** 225
Possibly the sexiest wine in the wine list. Soaring aromas of plowed hillside, campfire smoke & fresh date.
- 1999 **LOUIS JADOT Nuits-Saint-George Aux Thorey Premier Cru (Burgundy, France)** 165
This was cellared at the Domaine and shipped directly. A glorious vintage showing perfectly now.
- 2011 **COMTE LIGER BELAIR Vosne-Romanée (Burgundy, France)** 195
An exuberant and highly aromatic wine, brimming with strawberry preserves, hints of rose petal.
- 2009 **ARMAND ROUSSEAU Gevrey-Chambertin (Burgundy, France)** 250
Flamboyant and decidedly precocious. It lathers itself in fresh rose, blood orange and raspberry.
- 2012 **BURN COTTAGE (Central Otago, New Zealand)** 145
Dense and well structured... this took a while to come around, but it's singing now...also, it's organic.
- 2014 **LITTORAI Hirsch Vineyard (Sonoma Coast, United States)** 145
Hirsch is a cold site, yielding wines with firm nerve and tension. Wonderfully elegant.
- 2011 **MARTNELLI Three Sisters Vineyard Sea Ridge Measow (Sonoma Coast, United States)** 155
A lazy afternoon by the stream...you'll eat cherry pie and biscuits with whip cream...

GAMAY

- 2015 **JOIEFARM (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 75
You eat early season strawberries while having a cold shower on a hot summer afternoon.
- 2016 **TE MATA (Hawkes Bay, New Zealand)** 55
Bangin' and booty shakin'...ultimately crushable with a superb fruit bowl of flavor.
- 2008 **LOUIS JADOT Moulin á Vent Clos de Rochegres (Burgundy, France)** 88
At 10 years old this is starting to release all of its goodness. Faint chestnut with preserved cherry.

CABERNET FRANC

- 2013 **BOBINET Saumer Champigny Rueben (Loire Valley, France)** 75
You stumble upon wild blueberries fermenting among a frock of violets and lilies.
- 2014 **TH WINES (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 85
Punchy and feisty...slightly hilled blackberries smashed against your favorite tree...picnic time.

SYRAH

- 2007 **GUIGAL Hermitage (Rhône Valley, France)** 95
Soft bass cords ripple along the tongue and through the back of your head...perfect right now.
- 2011 **J.L. CHAVE Saint-Joseph (Rhône Valley, France)** 115
Double smoked bacon, warm blood, cold coffee grounds, faint waft of lily.
- 2011 **M&SOGIER Côte Rôtie (Rhône Valley, France)** 185
Wildly aromatic with a nose of smoked jasmine, sandalwood, lilac and bacon.....bacon!!
- 2013 **C.C. JENTSCH (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 90
This is the most awarded Canadian Syrah of all time. It is as close as Canada comes to Hermitage.
- 2010 **GRAMERCY (Columbia Valley, United States)** 125
The nose is of dark wool and mocha, the palate is unctuous and full of coffee beans and violets.
- 2009 **DONELAN Kobler Vineyard (Russian River Valley, United States)** 155
One of the purest noses of California Syrah ever. Camphor, thyme, dusty black rock., crisp bacon.
- 2014 **BRASH HIGGINS Shiraz (McLaren Vale, Australia)** 85
Supremely balanced and wonderfully fresh without giving up the succulent body you want from Shiraz.
- 2013 **ELDERTON Shiraz (Barossa Valley, Australia)** 75
A good expression of the Barossa with red currant jam, coffee cream, black tea, dried cherry
- 2008 **BAROSSA VALLEY ESTATE Shiraz E & E Black Pepper (Barossa Valley, Australia)** 150
A legend in the world of Shiraz...immense power and at a decade old drinking superbly.
- 2005 **DAN STANDISH Shiraz The Standish (Barossa Valley, Australia)** 195
A complex and massive wine. Black truffle, charred caraway seed and braised beef bones.

GRENAICHE

- 2015 **LASROCAS San Alejandro (Calatayud, Spain)** 50
Black pepper and juicy-squishy raspberries.
- 2008 **D'ARENBERG Custodian (McLaren Vale, Australia)** 70
Just beginning to show all of its soproressata, cherry fruit roll-up and worn leather....a killer drop.
- 2014 **VENUS "La Universal" Dido (Montsant, Spain)** 75
It caresses the palate with scorched earth and a hint of cream soda.
- 2012 **CLOS GELENA Formiga de Vellut (Priorat, Spain)** 85
Blow torched licorice, warm cherry tart with a sprinkling of pepper...
- 2012 **PEGAU Châteauneuf du Pape (Rhône Valley, France)** 155
Mince meat tarts, burnt bamboo, roasted lamb and cherry jubilee.
- 2000 **HENRI BONNEAU Châteauneuf du Pape Cuvée Henri Bonneau (Rhône Valley, France)** 275
The grandfather of Châteauneuf du Pape. Kirsch, cooked blood, forest earth.
- 2012 **BEAUCASTEL Châteauneuf du Pape (Rhône Valley, France)** 175
Grilled blueberries and raspberries that are rolled with blackstrap molasses and ground rocks

- 2015 **NOELIA RICCI Sangiovese Godenza (Emilia Romagna, Italy)** 70
Marvelous stuff...for all of your Sangiovese needs...cherries, smoke, forest.
- 2011 **AVIGNONESI Grifi (Tuscany, Italy)** 135
This may be one of the greatest expression of Sangiovese from Tuscany in 2011....a must try for enthusiasts.
- 2008 **CONTI COSTANTI Brunello di Montalcino (Tuscany, Italy)** 165
A very hot vintage boasting an over-filled bag of fig, raisin, toasted cashew and cold blood sausage.
- 2006 **BIONDI-SANTI Brunello di Montalcino (Tuscany, Italy)** 250
The king of Brunello and the sweetest of vintages, glory. The perfect cherry over the perfect campfire.

MERLOT

- 2012 **OSOYOOSLAROSE (Okanagan Valley, Canada)** 125
Possibly the best vintage of this wine to date. Decadent red currant, cigar box and faint chocolate.
- 1999 **CLOS L'ÉGLISE Pomerol (Bordeaux, France)** 250
A fine story of an open road filled with dried herbs, tar, licorice, preserved plums...it's a lovely road to be on.
- 2005 **CANON LA GAFFELIÈRE Saint Emilion (Bordeaux, France)** 275
A classic year offering immense fruit profiles and diligent structure....a perfect time for exploration.
- 2006 **ROBERT KEENAN Mailbox Vineyard Reserve Spring Mountain (Napa Valley, United States)** 135
This mountain grown fruit allows for firm tannin, smoked graphite and warm autumnal notes.
- 2004 **PAVIE Merlot ~ Cabernet Franc Saint Emilion (Bordeaux, France)** 325
A star in Bordeaux... cigar smoke, black currant jelly, warm chocolate shavings, very intense.

ZINFANDEL

- 2013 **HUNNICUT (Napa Valley, United States)** 95
All the warmth and sunshine of Napa Valley pumped into this bottle...just like being there, except you're here.
- 2012 **MARTINELLI Giuseppe & Luisa (Russian River Valley, United States)** 145
Fill a rollercoaster car with raspberry jam...sink in deep...now hit the mega-loop of madness...thrill ride!!

MALBEC

- 2014 **MAS DEL PERIE La Rogue (Cahors, France)** 65
Kinky and kooky with a penchant for the underground...expect liquid violets and tangy blackberry.
- 2014 **ZORZAL Tinto de Tiza Eggo (Mendoza, Argentina)** 68
Aged fully in a concrete egg shaped vessel...crushed black rocks coated with blueberries.

TEMPRANILLO

- 2009 **LOPEZ DE HARO Reserva (Rioja, Spain)** 55
All the aged wood, supple leather gloves and slightly dried cherry you could ever want.
- 2015 **TENTENUBLO Xérico (Rioja, Spain)** 75
Pack balsam wood under barely dried raspberries....gently light it on fire for just a moment....now juice it.
